


Cairo


Dinner at Egyptian Family






The Great Pyramid of Giza, the oldest of the Seven Wonders of the Ancient World, and the mysterious **Sphinx** can be found 5 km southwest of central Cairo.

Day 3 Cairo (B)

It is well worth spending a full day in Cairo. You will appreciate various collections of ancient Egyptian antiquities in the **Egyptian** Museum and then head to Old Cairo for a visit to the Citadel of Salah El Din. It is a medieval Islamic fortification, with the Mohammed Ali Mosque situated on higher ground. After that, pay a visit to the **Khan El** Khalili Bazaar, the best place to experience local life.

Continue your cruise to Luxor. Considered the world's greatest open air museum, Luxor has plenty of historical sites to visit. Today, you will explore the west bank of the Nile at Luxor, one of the most important archaeological sites in the world. The Valley of the **Kings** is famous for more than 60 tombs excavated for the Pharaohs and powerful nobles of the New Kingdom. Nearby is the Valley of the Queens, where wives of Pharaohs were buried in ancient times. Later, pay a visit to the Mortuary Temple of Hatshepsut. On the way, you will be amazedby the huge Colossi of Memnon.





excursion to the Greco-Roman **Sobek Temple**. Finally, your ship will stop at the port of Aswan.



Day 7 Nile Cruise (B, L, D)

After breakfast, you will embark for a visit to the **High Dam** and the **Temple of Philae**. In the afternoon, take a traditional, non-motorized **felucca** sailing around the Kitchener's Island and then disembark to enjoy some leisure time in the **Botanical Gardens**.


Hike the Ein Gedi Oasis











BEST PLACES TO VISIT



1 Amman

2 Petra

Jerash





In the Biblical tradition, Mount Nebo is the place where Moses first saw the Promised Land to which he would lead the exodus from Egypt. That's the reason why many believers are attracted by its fame. Standing on top of the summit of Mount Nebo, you can have a panoramic view of the Dead Sea and the Jordan Valley in distance.





Petra, a gem hiding in a basin among the mountains, is worth spending a full day to explore. The entrance to Petra is a canyon formed from a deep split in the sandstone rocks. Pass through this narrow passage, and



you will see an incomparable city. All the buildings in this city were carved into the rose-red rocks. After a 2-hour guided tour, you might want to explore at your own pace.




Enjoy some leisure time until a private transfer takes you to the airport for your homebound flight.

1. What can I expect from a private tour with Odynovo?

The amount of the deposit is usually 30% of the total price, depending on the actual itinerary and group size; and the balance should be paid at least 45 days before departure. Of course, you could also pay the full amount in a single payment if you prefer to.

3. How do I pay?

You can pay by PayPal, credit card or wire transfer; whichever is more convenient for you. When you're ready to book, your travel agent will send you the step-by-step payment guide. All the payments should be paid to Odynovo directly.

4. How can I get my refund if I have to cancel my booking?

5.Do I need to take out travel insurance for my trip?

Yes, please ensure that you have comprehensive travel insurance when travelling overseas, including health, life and disability insurance with medical evacuation, and trip cancellation insurance in the instance you have to cancel your tour prior to departure due to unforeseen circumstances.

6.What is the latest time that I can

make my reservation?

We suggest you make reservations at least 60 days before the departure date to avoid the peak season. However, we do accept last-minute reservations. If your reservation is very urgent, please call us directly by telephone. Although the availability of domestic flights, hotel rooms, some attractions and activities can not be guaranteed, we will try our best to help you arrange your tour.

7. How do I get a visa?

Traveling to the Middle East can be easier than you think as many of the region's countries either offer visa-free visits or allow you to obtain a visa online. For those who don't, they make it possible for you to get one upon arrival.

Egypt-E-Visa / Visa on Arrival

Visas are required for most nationals visiting Egypt. Citizens of the US, UK, Australia, New Zealand, Canada, and the EU can apply for a single-entry, 30-day tourist visa online (https://visa2egypt.gov.eg) or obtain a visa upon arrival at any of the Egyptian ports of entry including Cairo International Airport.

Morocco-Visa Free

US, UK, Australian, New Zealand, Canadian, and EU nationals do not need a visa to travel to Morocco for stays of up to 90 days, with a passport valid for at least 6 months from the date of entry.

Israel–Visa Free

US, UK, Australian, New Zealand, Canadian, and EU nationals do not need a visa to enter Israel for tourism purposes for a maximum stay of 90 days. Passports must be valid for a minimum period of 6 months from the date of entry into Israel.

Jordan-Visa on Arrival

Most nationals need a visa to enter Jordan and they can get one upon arrival at the international airports and most of Jordan's land borders. If you are planning to stay in Jordan for more than two nights, we recommend buying the Jordan Pass (www.jordanpass.jo) online before arrival. It not only waives the visa fee, but also allows you to visit many Jordan attractions for free, including Petra.

Turkey-E-Visa / Visa-Free

US, UK, Australian, and Canadian passport holders can purchase a Jordan visa online (https://ww-w.evisa.gov.tr/en/) before traveling for a stay of 90 days. New Zealand nationals and many European citizens such as the French and German can enjoy visa-free visits in Turkey for 90 days.

Kenya-E-Visa / Visa on Arrival

To enter Kenya, a visa is required for most nationalities, including US, UK, Australian, Canadian, and New Zealand passport holders. You can apply for a single-entry tourist visa online (www.evisa.go.ke) or obtain a visa on arrival at the airport. It is advisable to get your visa in advance to avoid long queues at the airport. If you also want to visit Uganda and Rwanda, you can apply for an East Africa Tourist Visa valid for 90 days, which allows multiple entries into three countries. The visa can be applied in advance at a Kenyan embassy or consulate or upon arrival at Nairobi International Airport. Note that you'll also need to bring your Yellow Fever vaccination certificate to visit Kenya.

8.Do you offer any discounts if we have many people in our group?

Yes, our quotation is based on the size of your group. The more people in your group, the more discounts can you have. Private tours will be expensive for solo traveler; therefore, we do suggest you think of travelling with friends or families if it is possible for you to get a companion.

9.Do I need to bring my medical record with me?

Yes, we suggest you take your medical record with you in case that you need it in the event of an emergency, and please also take the notes of your doctor's name, address and phone number, emergency contact name and phone number, and your insurance company's name, address and phone number.

10.Am I expected to leave gratuities?

Tipping is a custom in Middle East. It would be usual to give your tour guide and driver a tip at the end of your tour if he/she has done a good job, and the amount is entirely at your discretion. It is not mandatory, but always much appreciated.

BROCHURE AND VALIDITY

While Odynovo makes every effort to ensure the accuracy of its publications, it cannot be held responsible for typographical or printing errors or omissions. All information, including prices and inclusions, should be rechecked prior to booking.

PRICE

All prices in this brochure are in US dollars. Any changes in the cost of land transport, hotels, flights, taxes, fuel and currency exchange rates may influence the prices. It is important that you reconfirm all the information at the time of booking and prior to making the final payment.

RESERVATION

Usually, 30% of the total cost of the tour is required as a deposit at the time of booking. The deposit may be of a higher amount depending on the specific itinerary and the policies of the suppliers, such as hotels, airlines, etc. During high season, in order to secure your reservation, you may be required to pay a higher amount of the deposit or to pay the balance in advance.

PAYMENT
